A Working Thesaurus for Collaboration is an attempt to bring together the many individual performances enacted during and after the moment of collaboration. The document draws from the arrangement of words in Roget's Thesaurus (first published in 1852 before 'collaboration' was in common usage), and the safeguarding of intangible heritage in UNESCO's strategy of building inventories. It is a writing tool that draws from academic, military, political, and performance vernaculars in the hopes of cataloguing the nuances and changeability of the term as it becomes ever more ubiquitous and unchallenged.
